

**Minutes of the Fyfield and Tubney Parish Council Meeting  
held on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> October 2021.**

**1. Apologies**

Apologies had been received from

**2. Casual Vacancy.**

Following the resignation of Mr John Watts and confirmation that no request for an election had been submitted to the Returning Officer, the parish was free to co-opt in order to fill the vacancy.

The Clerk had sought interest through the web site and the Parish Mailing List and had received one response from Mr Dimitrios Hatzis.

It was unanimously **resolved** to co-opt Mr Hatzis to fulfil the vacancy.

**3. Next Meeting.**

Mr Mellor would be unable to attend the next scheduled meeting on the 11<sup>th</sup> November and the Clerk would be away the following week.

It was **resolved** to reschedule the meeting to Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> December. Given that the White Hart would be in full Christmas swing, it was felt that the meeting should once more be held in the church.

**4. War Memorial.**

Mr Greaves stated that a detailed quotation should be available in time for the next meeting.

**5. Tubney Bus Stop Lights.**

In view of the excessive cost of supplying mains electricity to the light on the north side of the road, the **Clerk to seek confirmation from OCC that two solar lights would be a cheaper alternative.**

**6. Coach Road.**

Mr Woodward requested that the Coach Road be put on the agenda for the next meeting. The Clerk had registered issues with encroaching vegetation in the past and got no corrective action. Similar problems existed with pot holes on Digging Lane near Woodhouse Farm. This seemed to be an ongoing problem with Fix My Street to be raised with the County Councillor.

There being no other items, the Chairman closed the meeting at 8:00pm.
